

Arden Place Rules

Tennis Courts

(2008)

1. Courts may be used between 7:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M. daily.
2. Tennis courts are a significant feature of life at Arden Place and are widely used and expensive to maintain. They are to be used for traditional tennis only. Other athletic activities including soccer tennis are not permitted on the tennis courts. Footwear specifically designed for hard surface tennis courts must be worn when using the courts. Traditional tennis attire, including shirts, must be worn at all times.
3. Players can reserve court time by signing names on the board located on the front porch wall of the Clubhouse.
4. The courts may not be reserved more than 48 hours in advance. The reservations should not be erased until the final players of the day have taken the court.
5. Each resident may reserve time up to 1 ½ hours per day. If a resident reserves a time and then cannot play, the name should be removed from the board so that others can reserve the time. Court time is forfeited after 10 minutes of wait time.
6. Guests are to be accompanied by a resident at all times. A resident may not accompany a guest to the courts and then leave them to play by themselves.
7. Adult residents have court priority after 4:00 P.M. on weekdays and all day on weekends. Children of residents may reserve court time between 7:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. any weekday. If a court is open on any day or evening, children of residents may play. During these times, children are to be given 15 minutes notice before adults assume court time.
8. After play is completed, please close and lock the court gate securely.
9. Skateboards and street shoes are not permitted on the courts.
10. Proper court etiquette is expected at all times.
11. The tennis court key also fits the pool gate.
